Grenoble and Chambéry airports get a 15th scheduled air service : ROMA

This new destination brings to 15th the number of destinations served on a scheduled basis. Both airports now have 10 scheduled airlines on top of the biggest French Tour operator (Marmara / Etapes Nouvelles) who offers weekly flight to Marrakech and Monastir. All new routes' first flights will spread between November 14th and December 24th 2005.

Last news

- British Airways and Ryanair extend and strengthen their winter program
- British airways is extending its winter program (5 weekly flights) to the end of April.
- Ryanair, because of strong forward bookings is strengthening its program from London Stansted by adding additional frequencies on peak winter times. On these periods Ryanair will have up to 11 frequencies per week between London and Grenoble airport !
- Grenoble airport traffic on 30/09/05 reached 207 000 passengers and is therefore already exceeding the 2004 annual traffic which was 204 400 passengers. With all this new carriers Grenoble airport should see its traffic more than double next year.
- As far as Chambéry airport is concerned, the traffic should grow by 4% compared to last year.
